## Storm of the Century

*30 cm or 12 inches of rain fell in less than 10 hours.*



We happened to be in the capital, Ouagadougou, when the biggest rain since 1919 hit the city. The streets were flooded, shops destroyed, cars damaged but the worst part was the mud houses collapsing from all the water. At least 150,000 people are left homeless. A whole section of the

city was evacuated and given sanctuary in the soccer stadium.
